A brief description; Murphy Yard has been reconfigured with Hackney on a reverse spur to your left and a new spur for Murphy Pulpwood Yard. Copperhill; North end of Copperhill Yard has been reconfigured to have 2 AD tracks and the work/storage tracks have each been extended by 5 cars each. The Helix is up to the point of starting the Loop Trestle. And the final loop to the upper level. There is also a tight loop under the helix for turning locos around for Copperhill.

Our intention is to finish the helix construction and then go back and finish Murphy, Copperhill, and the helix mountain before continuing with the upper level. We need help with this scenery, buildings and finish work. If you are comfortable, please feel free to come join us on Wednesdays or another day if you want to come in by yourself.
