Club Safety

The TriState Model Railroaders club is a functional museum. Everything in it must be treated with care. No part of the club, the layout, or the equipment can be considered toys.

While in the clubhouse, you must follow certain rules.

- Treat others with respect.
- No Running.
- No Food or Drink on or near the layout.
- Take caution using stools.
- When reaching, watch your sleeves or anything else that can damage the layout.
- If you are not sure, ask.

The layout is fragile. If you are not a member, do not touch anything on the layout, do not throw switches (either manual or electric), do not pickup locomotives or other rolling stock.

If you see something out of place, report it to one of the members.

Members must:

- Know where the Exits and Fire Extinguishers are.
- Know where the First Aid Kit is.
- Know where your badge is, and wear it at all times the public is in the clubhouse.
